How to Obtain the Jubilee Indulgence

The Vatican has detailed how to obtain plenary indulgences removing temporal punishment for sin through the merits of Jesus during the 2025 Jubilee Year. One should visit a designated Pilgrimage Site (OLOV or St. Paul's Cathedral locally) and fulfill the following conditions:

1. Detachment from sin (even lesser venial sin)
2. Confession within about twenty days
3. Receiving Holy Communion
4. Pray for the Holy Father's intentions (i.e., an Our Father and a Hail Mary)
