

## **How to Obtain the Jubilee Indulgence**

The Vatican has detailed how to obtain plenary indulgences removing temporal punishment for sin through the merits of Jesus during the 2025 Jubilee Year. One should visit a designated Pilgrimage Site (OLOV or St. Paul's Cathedral locally) and fulfill the following conditions:

- 1. Detachment from sin (even lesser venial sin)
- 2. Confession within about twenty days
- 3. Receiving Holy Communion
- 4. Pray for the Holy Father's intentions (i.e., an Our Father and a Hail Mary)
